

Donation Agreement

When new Community members “downsize” and move into smaller living spaces at Daybreak, they often have items that don’t fit in their new space but that would still be useful to them and to other members of the Community. We have a number of community spaces where items that are being lent or donated to the Community can be kept and used, and the various teams responsible for these spaces have the authority to accept or decline items being donated or lent to the Community.

Donated items will be considered permanent gifts to the Community, to be kept, used, or disposed of by the Community, and may not be reclaimed by the donor without permission of the Community.

Loaned items must be clearly marked with the name of the lender and the conditions under which the items will be returned to the lender. At any time the Community may require the lender to reclaim any items that have been lent. A record will be kept of all loans to the Community. The Community is not responsible for the condition of any loaned item during the time it is loaned or upon its return.

Teams and areas of responsibility:

- Common House Team – guest rooms, guest bathroom, yoga/meditation room, arts and crafts room, family/TV room, living room, exercise room, laundry room, patio, janitor’s closet
- Food Team – kitchen, café
- Workshop Team – basement workshop
- Garden Team – garden closet by elevator, garden shed on Delaware, garden beds, lawn, other outdoor areas
- Kids Team – kids room, outdoor play areas, toy storage under stairs
- Tech Team – computer, printer, and other technology equipment
- Bike Team – bike room
- Multiple teams – downstairs closets, shelving units in downstairs hallway, rooftop deck
