Plenary Participation: We value including and hearing all voices.

Plenary Dialogue and Communication

- Pay attention to impact over intent: Sometimes, even when our intentions are positive, the impact of our words, our actions, or our community policies might have unintended or negative impacts.
- Listen to understand: Avoid formulating your response/counterpoints while you are listening. Be curious and open to different viewpoints.
- **Speak from your own experience:** Avoid generalizations and speaking for others. When using examples, be specific.
- **Take Space/Make Space:** Be aware of your comfort level speaking. If you speak frequently, leave space for other voices. If you tend to hold back, share your perspective.
- **Take ownership of your statements:** Be willing to help others understand your ideas and point of view. Speak your truth responsibly and with compassion.
- Ask for clarification: It's ok to break-in with a question for clarification before moving on to next speaker.
- Avoid side conversations
